PRE-STUDIES PROGRAM (PSP)

PSP is a one year pre-studies program at Fachhochschule des Mittelstands (FHM) – University of Applied Science.



PSP is primarily designed for qualified international students

- who intend to enroll on a Bachelor's program in engineering, medicine or economics in Germany
- whose secondary-school diploma does not qualify for direct access to a Bachelor's program at a German University.



The PSP provides you with a solid academic foundation in the individual disciplines of engineering, medicine or economics. Specialized German courses raise your language level.

Having passed the final examination (FSP) at the end of the PSP program you are eligible to apply for a Bachelor study at the FHM – University of Applied Science and other private or public universities in Germany.

Housing




We arrange accommodation for all PSP students. All apartments are fully furnished with beds, wardrobes, desks, chairs and WiFi. Each apartment comprises a communal bathroom and a shared kitchen. Until June 15th: complete your PSP application form

6 weeks later: get your PSP admission

Apply for your visa

July –September: Learn as much German as you can, we will help you to find a suitable German course for the summer

October 15th: PSP (3 trimester)

June 15th: “application training”

July 15th: Deadline for sending your application to German Universities

July/August: Take the entrance exam (Feststellungsprüfung)

October: semester start at German universities

DOCUMENT CHECKLIST – PSP

1. Copy of your secondary-school certificate and, if applicable, a university entrance exam certificate of your home country
2. University transcript of records from your home country, if applicable
3. Officially certified translation of your original certificates (if the originals are not in German or English)
4. Proof of sufficient German language proficiency
5. Résumé in tabular form
6. Motivation letter
7. Two passport-size photos
8. Passport copy

HOW TO APPLY?

1. Complete the application form and send the required documents to u-pass
2. Wait for u-pass read your documents
3. Pass the written test
4. Pass the oral test
5. When accepted students receive the admission acceptance form, it has to be signed and send back to u-pass via email as scanned copy
6. Transfer fees
7. Open blocked bank account in Germany
8. Receive the original admission letter
9. Apply for visa
10. Pack your bags and fly to Germany
